

Our second annual Love Conway event is quickly approaching. Last year was our first time to have this event where we were 100% focused on serving our community. It was a part of our 2023 Love Your Neighbor emphasis, but it was such a great success that we decided immediately that it needed to be a part of our annual calendar of events.

The heart of Love Conway is just that...to love on Conway. In our recent sermon series, Membership Matters, we discussed the local church's purpose and importance. One metaphor that we came back to again and again was the comparison of the church to an embassy for heaven. As individual believers, we are ambassadors for heaven, and we gather together in local churches, which become embassies for heaven. But an embassy is not simply there to be present; it is there to make an impact. So, too, the church is not here simply to be present, but to make an impact on the world around us. 
Wednesday In The Word
