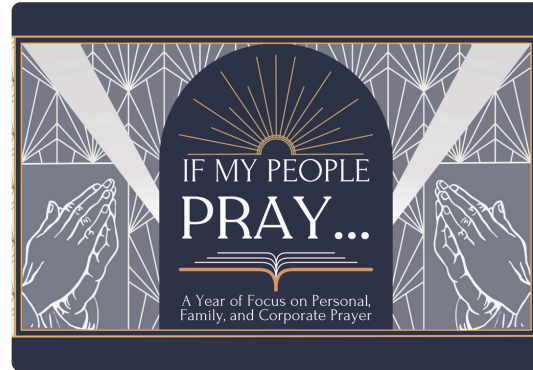


Christmas Worship Services
